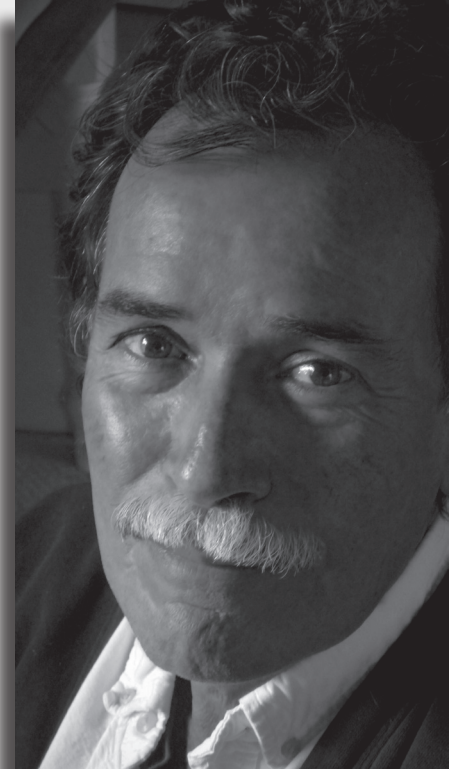
from shoeshine boy to Pulitzer Prize-winning photographer
